EMERGENCY PLANNING FOR YOUR PET

Pre-Disaster

1. Obtain a pet carrier large enough
for your pet to stand and turn
around in. Include a cover (sheet
or blanket) to place over the car-

rier so your pet feels more secure. You may want to include a favorite toy or chew bone.

- 2. Make prior arrangements for your pet to stay in a kennel or with a friend.
- 3. If you plan to evacuate check in advance to see if a pet is also welcome. AAA has a listing of pet friendly hotels and motels. If you plan to go to a shelter, make prior arrangements for your pet(s) with a kennel, an animal clinic, or with dependable friends.
- 4. Stock up on pet food and pet supplies. Include newspapers, plastic bags, cleanser and disinfectants to handle pet waste.
- 5. Be sure to have an adequate supply of any medication your pet needs as well as a record of all inoculations and vaccinations.
- 6. Most importantly <u>keep identification on your pet.</u>

*If you have no other alternative but to leave your pet at home, choose an easily cleaned area (bathroom for example), away from windows. Multiple pets should be kept separate.

Post Disaster

1. An altered environment may cause your pet to become disoriented. Keep your pet leashed.



Fallen power lines as well as roaming reptiles brought in by high water can be hazardous to your pet.

3. If your pet is lost, notify
Neighborhood Services immediately.

Special note: Arrangements have been made with individuals who are willing

to foster a pet if you are unable to return to your home. If you need this service or if you feel you can foster a pet, please call Neighborhood Services at 871-5042.

Remember: If it is not safe for you to remain in your home during a hurricane, it is not safe for your pet either. Please make emergency plans!
